## Customized Tour

### Suggested Educational Tour Stops

- ◆ **Hawaii Volcanoes National Park:** Features one of the world's most active volcanoes that has been in a nearly continuous eruption since 1983.
- ◆ **Hulihe'e Palace:** Built in 1838 by Governor John Adams Kuakini this was a vacation spa for Hawaiian royalty.
- ◆ **'Imiloa Astronomy Center:** Showcases astronomy from ancient Hawai'i to the newest technology of today. There are many interactive exhibits and a digital full dome planetarium with amazing shows.
- ◆ **Kaloko Honokohau National Historical Park:** Ancient Hawaiian settlement with fishpond, plants and wildlife. Ranger-led programs available for all grade levels.
- ◆ **Mokuaika Church:** First Christian church built in the State of Hawaii.
- ◆ **Mokupapapa Discovery Center:** Focuses on the coral reef and ecosystem management. Includes interactive displays, 3-D models, immersive theater and a 2,500 gallon salt-water aquarium.
- ◆ **Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawai'i Authority (NELHA):** State-operated science and technology park where lectures will cover the uses of deep seawater among other things.
- ◆ **Onizuka Space Museum:** Facility dedicated to the late Ellison Onizuka with interactive exhibits and videos that showcase the history of manned space flight, physics and daily life in space.
- ◆ **Pacific Tsunami Museum:** Includes presentation that covers the science of tsunamis, historical information about Hilo and personal accounts of tsunami survivors.
- ◆ **Punalu'u Black Sand Beach:** Popular black sand beach where green sea turtles are found.
- ◆ **Pu'ukohola Heiau:** War heiau built by Kamehameha the Great.
- ◆ **Pu'uhonua O Honaunau:** Sacred place where people who broke the kapu could seek refuge.
- ◆ **Kona Coffee Living History Farm:** Depicts the lives of Japanese immigrants living and working on the farm between 1920 and 1945.
- ◆ **West Hawaii Explorations Academy (WHEA):** Features exhibits such as the octopus tank, shark tank, bat ray tank, electric car exhibit, and a greenhouse area.
